


MINIMAL PROGRESS IN SCALING UP HARM REDUCTION

- Countries with Opioid Substitution Therapy (OST)

EVEN THOUGH HARM REDUCTION SAVES LIVES...


Where access to harm reduction services is limited: Philippines
HIV prevalence among people who inject drugs has soared from 1% to 41.6%



Where access has increased: Ukraine
HIV prevalence among people who inject drugs has more than halved from 41.8% to 19.7%

NSP IN PRISONS: SOUND THE ALARM


11 Countries had NSP in prisons in 2012
